Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of sections of Bal vatika shall be restricted to 3 (1 section each for Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to X shall be restricted to 17. Any further increase shall require prior permission of the Board and shall be subject to compliance with the affiliation Bye laws and availability of rooms of >500 sq ft dimensions.
2	Ramp at the entrance is not seen in the videography. A portion of ramp to access upper floor is seen which is very steep and does not seem to be navigable by a wheelchair-bound student/staff. Thus, the school is required to construct ramp at the entrance with proper handrails as per guidelines and dismantle the ramp to access upper floor and either install a lift or construct ramp with proper incline and safety features as per the provisions laid down in RPWD Act and Board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
3	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate freely inside the cubicle.

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	Temporary wooden wedges are placed at the entry of CWSN toilets. The CwSN toilets are not seen on every floor. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
4	Boys urinals are seen without partitions. Hence the school is directed to fix partitions and submit the videographic compliance within 3 months.
5	The Computer lab is seen understocked. The total number of computer mentioned by the school is not seen in the videography. As per circular No.10/2023, 01 (One) Computer System per 18 (eighteen) students with minimum of 40 computer systems must be available in computer Lab. Hence the school is directed to upgrade computer lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
6	The Maths lab does not have storage facility and appropriate seating facility. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
7	Composite lab does not have permanent workstations separately for Physics, Chemistry and Biology sections with appropriate fixture like sinks with water connection, piped gas supply on the demonstration tables. seating facility is not appropriate, stools with proper height is required. Curtains are seen on the windows, which are fire threats to students. Safety features like exhaust fan, fire extinguisher and emergency exit are also not seen in the lab. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
8	Library is seen undersized and understocked. Reading area for students are inadequate and there is no separate reading space for staff. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
9	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Chennai within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.

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6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
